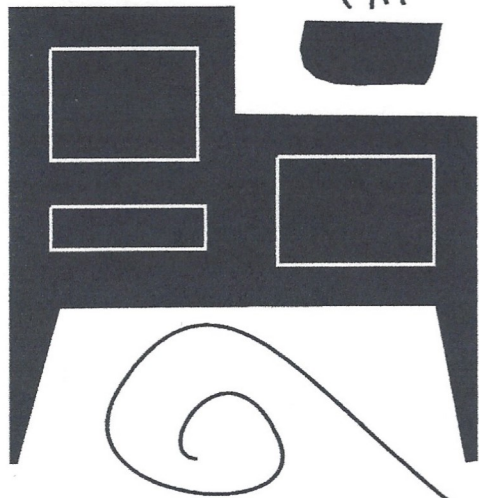

Do to expenses increasing, it is necessary to raise our RV Park rates.

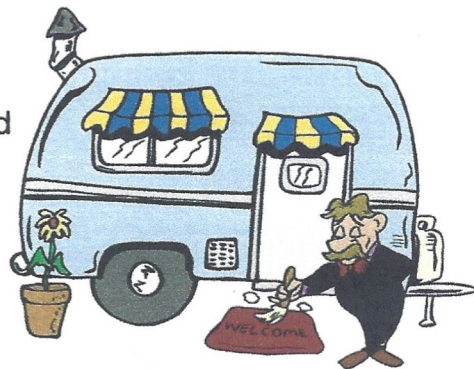
As of November 1, 2023, new rates are as follows;

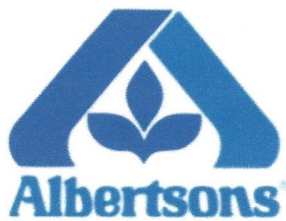
